



The Writing Process

Prewriting: Think About It

Draw, talk, and plan. Use circle maps, storyboards, and pictures.

Drafting: Sloppy Copy

Turn ideas into sentences.

Revising: Make It Better

Read over your draft, add ideas, and make sure it makes sense.

Proofreading: Make It Correct

Find and correct mistakes with capitals, periods, and spelling.

Publishing: Make It Beautiful

Copy it over without mistakes to put on the wall, in a book, or send in a letter



Parts of Speech

noun: person, place, or thing

adjective: a word that describes

verb: action words



Reading Strategies

Predict: Make a smart guess about what is going to happen.

Make Connections: Connect what's happening in the story with your own life.

Clarify: Look closer to understand confusing parts.

Visualize: Get a picture in your brain of what is happening in a story.

Sum up: Tell what has happened so far in a story.

Reread: Read again to clarify or to remember what you have forgotten or may have missed the first time.
